Working in watercolor, Judy Levins paints her world; people, places and everyday moments. Her expressive paintings celebrate connection, memory and the stories that surround us.

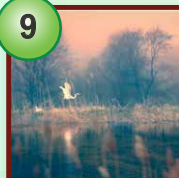

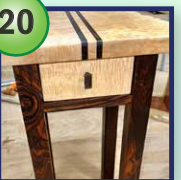
